30 1971 Unveils tributes to herself and B-P at Gilwell Park, Essex.

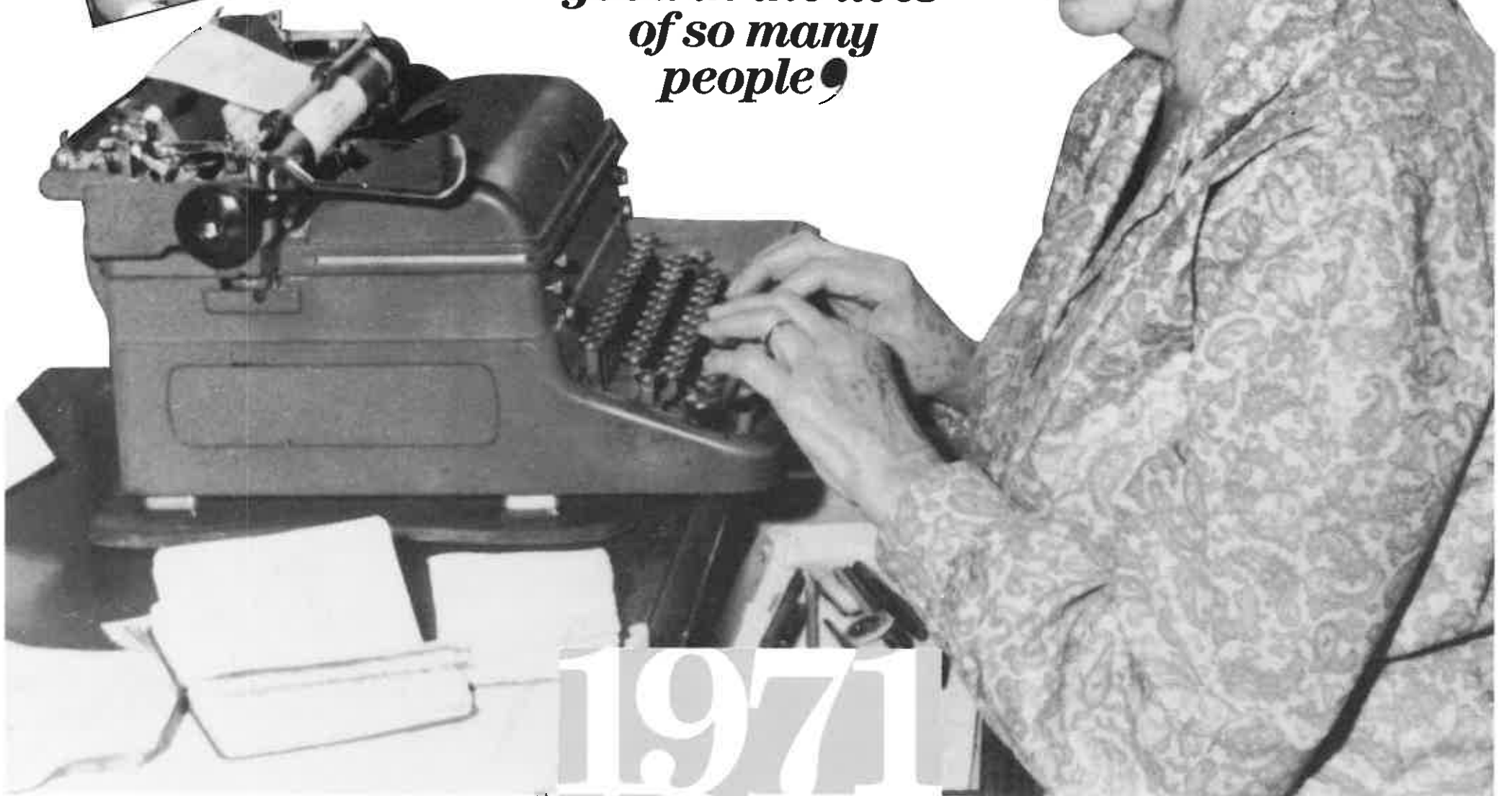
